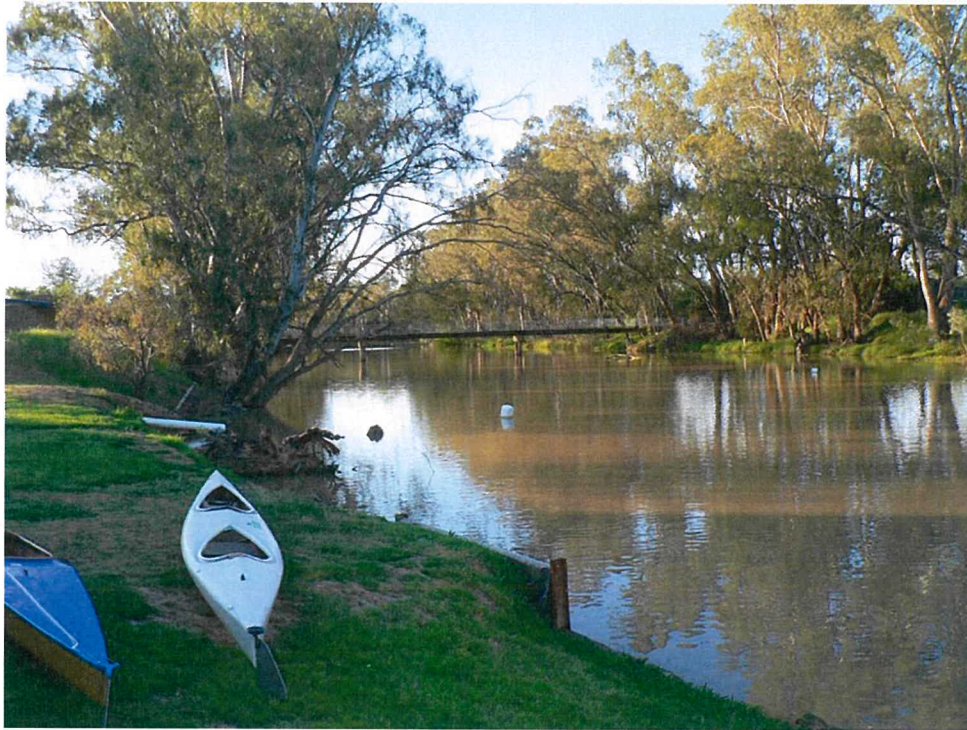

## Nathalia Canoe Club - starts Tues 10<sup>th</sup> October



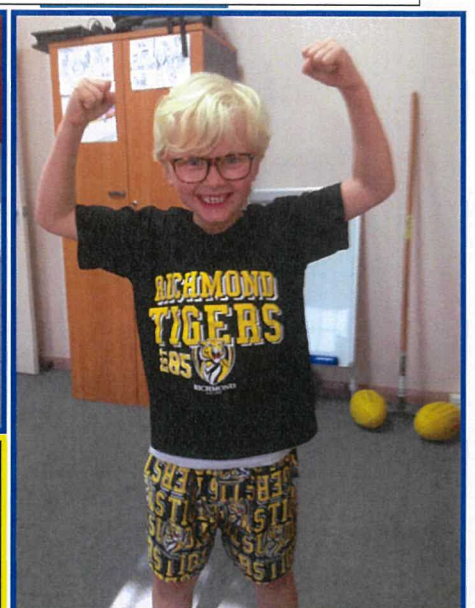
**Meets on Tuesdays @ 4.00 pm onwards (Terms 4 & 1)
