Do students at schools need to wear a face mask?

This is the most recent information I have regarding students wearing masks at school:

(Secondary College) Students aged 12 and over must continue to wear face masks indoors and outdoors, unless a lawful exception applies.

From Monday the 18th of October, face masks are required for students in Year 3 to Year 6, only when indoors on school premises, unless an exception applies.

Exceptions for all year levels include:

Students with a physical or mental disability are not required to wear a face mask where their disability means it would not be suitable.

Restrictions and regulations are constantly adapting and I will endeavour to keep families informed of the most recent advice from the Department of Education.

Unless there is a change of direction from the department, from Monday all students in grades 3—6 will be required to wear a mask when they are indoors when they are at school or travelling on a school bus.

Students are asked to bring a mask from home but the school has a supply of disposable masks that will be provided to students.

Wearing masks is a proven method of restricting the transmission of COVID 19 in our community. The wearing of masks by year 3—6 students will be implemented according to the guidelines that we have been provided with.

Students Attending On-Site (Don't forget your broad brimmed school hat!)

All students in grades Prep, one and two should be attending on-site every day for all of term 4.

In weeks two and three:

Grades 3 and 4 attend on Tuesday the 12th, Wednesday the 13th, Tuesday the 19th and Wednesday the 20th of October.

Grades 5 and 6 attend on Thursday the 14th, Friday the 15th, Thursday the 21st and Friday the 22nd of October.

All students return to school on Tuesday the 26th of October. (week 4 of the term)

Lunch Orders

Student are once again able to put in lunch orders that will be supplied by the Nathalia Secondary College canteen.

Lunch orders must be lodged first thing in the morning and they will be delivered to the school by 12.30pm.

Please write the order on a paper bag with your child's name and grade on the front and the money inside.
