Family Barbecue

Parent Information Session

Ms O'Callaghan and Ms Willcock, our Prep—1 teachers, will be running a parent information session on how parents can help their child with reading. This session will coincide with the family barbecue and will run from 4.00—4.30pm.

Swimming

The school swimming program will operate on the following dates:

February 11—15, February 20—22 and February 25—26. (February 18 and 19 are the scheduled dates for the secondary colleges' swimming sports.)

Children who are in levels one and two will swim from 12.00—12.30pm and levels three and above will swim from 12.30—1.00pm. The children will get changed at school and walk to and from the pool for their sessions.

We have a number of children who have enrolled at the school since our 2018 swimming program and they will be assessed on day one and put into a group that reflects their swimming ability.

Parents who would like to assist with the program should contact Chris at the school as soon as possible. The swimming program is a compulsory part of the curriculum and establishes life long skills for the children.

The Royal Life Saving National Drowning Report shows that there were 249 drowning deaths and an estimated 551 hospitalisations resulting from non-fatal drowning incidents across Australia between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018. Water safety is a life skill that should be embraced by all families.

Principles to take part in a special run to start the fun off - more

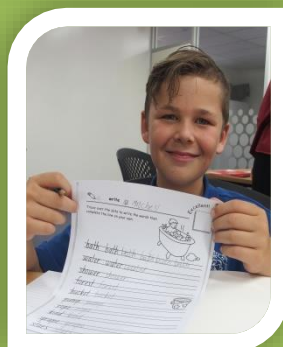

The 2019 Scholarship applications are open to Indigenous children from Prep through to Grade 6 who are attending Primary School in the Goulburn Valley.

2019 Application Dates

Applications open on Monday, 4 February 2019

Applications close on Friday, 1 March 2019 at 5:00pm.

We can only accept applications within these dates.

Note: There are limited Scholarships available.

How to Apply

If you would like to apply for a Ganbina 2019 Primary School Education Scholarship, please **call our office on 03 5821 7333** to arrange an appointment with us.

Appointment bookings open on Monday, 4 February 2019.

When you come into the office for your appointment, please bring with you:

- If your child is in prep, the enrolment letter from your child's school.
- Your child's 2018 end of year school report.
- A document that shows where you live (bank statement, electricity or gas bill).
- Proof of identification from parents or guardians (driver's licence, birth certificate or health care card).

If you are over 11 please note on the form below

The season runs from Term 2 till late August with no games during school holidays and long weekends. The approximate cost is \$80 per child.
