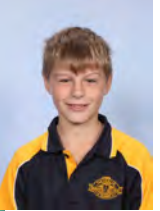
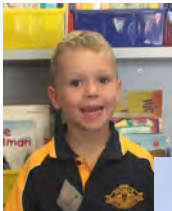
Kaiela Indigenous Arts
