

Nathalia Primary School Tops the Network

This week the school received NAPLAN trend data of student outcomes over the past three years. (Not 2019 data). The table above represents reading growth for students at Nathalia Primary School who completed NAPLAN in Year 3 and again in Year 5. As you can see the percentage of students with high gain in that period is 33%, which places Nathalia Primary School well above the State average and, in fact, the highest of similar schools in the Shepparton Network. This is a great achievement and a credit to the teachers, staff, students and the programs that have been implemented over this period.

The work of parents in this achievement must also be acknowledged. I appreciate the parents who support the school and contribute to the school's culture in so many ways. Parents listen to their children read at home and some are able to come into the school and listen to other children read. The working relationship between teachers and parents is so important in achieving the highest possible outcomes for the children.
