Title – Pop Up Art.

Art Elements – Line/Shape/Form/Colour

Equipment.

Cardstock/cover paper or other heavier weight paper.

Colourful cover paper scraps, construction paper or white cartridge (add your own colour)

Scissors, glue stick, textas, pencils.

Instructions.

Making the Pop Up.

Fold A4 cardstock or similar, in half.

Cut 2 parallel slits from the folded edge, somewhere around the middle of the paper. How wide do you want the pop up section?

Fold the tab up and crease it. (you are on the outside of the folded paper)

Open up the card & pop the cut part in towards the inside of the card.

Glue cardstock on to a slightly bigger piece of colour construction paper/cover paper.

Be careful not to glue the pop up section down.

Adding the Details.

Decide what you want your work to be about.

A garden theme? A city? Your family? What will you put on the pop up section?

For example, a 'space' themed work might include planets, stars, asteroids, aliens and maybe a rocket on the pop up section.

When you have decided on your theme, you will need to add details to the background and foreground.

Work with the card laying open and flat. Don't put anything on the pop up section yet.

Cut your shapes from scrap papers & add extra texta details. Glue on your details. You can also draw details straight on the cardstock.

Finally, create the piece to go on the pop up. Make sure not to make it too tall, so it doesn't poke out of the card when it's folded.

Extra.

Make another pop up but this time add more pop up sections. Have fun everyone!
